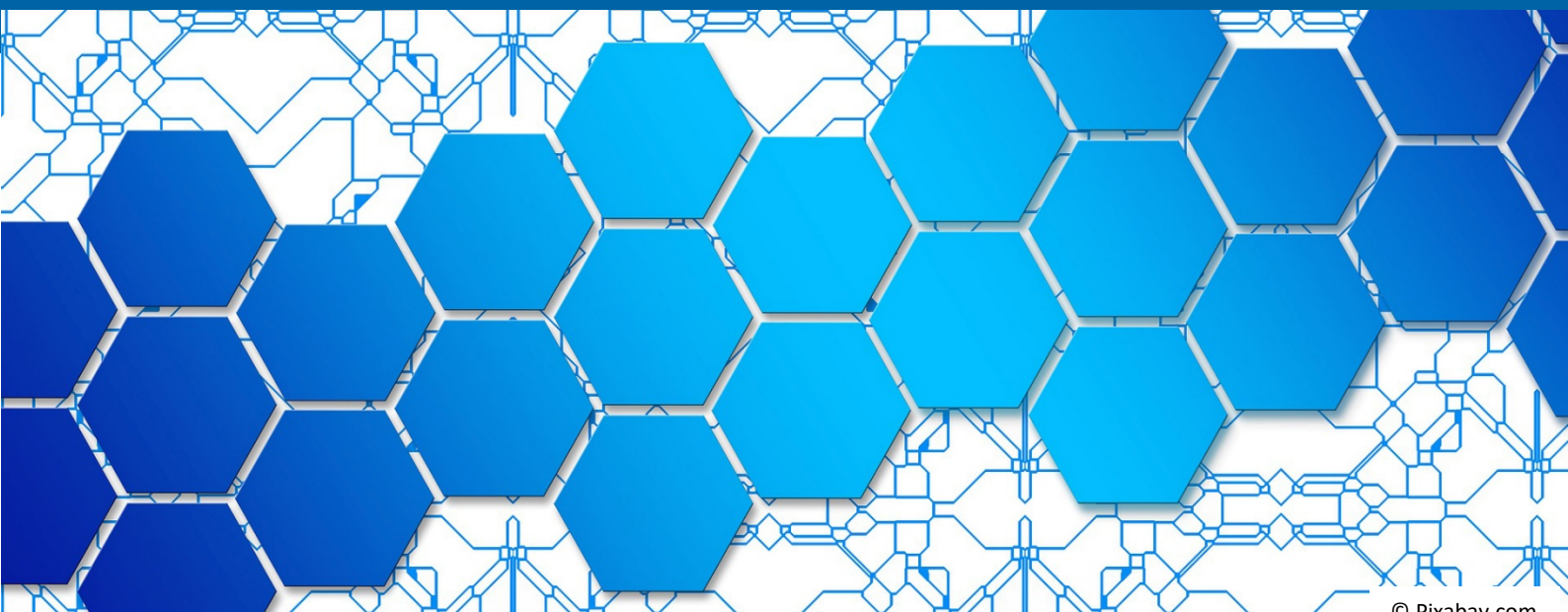




# Vienna Doctoral School in Chemistry - DoSChem: Virtual Information Event for DoSChem Students
